<b>Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) in Population Studies</b> (Full time/Part time)	Candidates having M.Phil/ Master's degree in Population Studies of a recognised university with atleast 55% of marks. For part-time Ph.D., two years' experience after MPS or one year experience after M.Phil in Population Studies is essential. \* Government of India Fellowships @ Rs.12,000/- per month for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> years and Rs.14,000/- per month for 3<sup>rd</sup> year respectively available for the Indian students who have qualified NET for Lectureship only in population or its interdisciplinary subjects conducted by the UGC. Such Ph.D. fellowship also carries a contingency grant of Rs. 10,000/- per year for the first two years and Rs. 20,500/- for the third year. However the candidates, without NET qualification shall be given fellowship @ Rs.6,250/- per month for the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> years, and Rs.7,000/- per month for the 3<sup>rd</sup> year, with a contingency grant of Rs. 10,000/- per year. Number of seats will be as per the availability of fellowships at the time of admission.

Reservation for SC, ST, OBC & PH candidates will be considered as per the Government of India norms.
