13. National Family Health Survey-1

National Family Health Survey – I conducted during 1992-93. This Survey covered 26 states of India and covered a total target sample of more than 90,000 ever married women in the ages of 15-49. Full text in pdf form of all the 26 reports and summary reports of 26 states available in CD-R media.

14. National Family Health Survey-2

The NFHS-2 sample covers more than 99 percent of India's population living in all 26 states. It does not cover the union territories. NFHS-2 is a household survey with an overall target sample size of approximately 90,000 ever-married women in the age group 15-49. This e-book presents findings based on the analysis of all the states in India.

15. National Family Health Survey-3

The NFHS-3 covered all 29 states in India, which comprise more than 99 percent of India's population. NFHS-3 is design to provide estimates of key indicators for India as a whole and with the exception of HIV prevalence for all 29 states by urban-rural residence.

16. District Level Household Survey (DLHS) – District Level Household Survey previously known as Reproductive and Child Health (RCH) survey. The sample size for district varies approximately 1000-15000 households. The recent third round has been conducted in 601 districts in 2007-08. It covers a sample of 7, 20, 320 households and 6, 43, 944 ever-married women.
