

Digitization of Census of India 1872-1941 volumes in IIPS: An announcement

Introduction: The library activities either in-house or service must be centered on the library users. Due to the technological impact, the user wants the information irrespective of format, time and location of information, therefore, digitization of information is indispensable. It serves, the storage, organization, retrieval and dissemination functions effectively as compared to printed volumes. Moreover, it preserves the rare collection which is considered as important from parent organization or the public point of view. The digitized volume can multi access at a time, remote access, easy to copy, easy and faster for transportation, and once printed volume has been digitized, the people can view the text, graph, charts, tables content the volume can be made available without time limitation as well as life of the printed volume can be extended further because due to digitized material access it eliminates human touch, wear & tear and can be stored in controlled climate etc.

International Institute for Population Sciences (IIPS) serves as a regional institute for training and research in population studies for the ESCAP region. It was established in Bombay in July 1956, till July 1970 it was known as Demographic Training and Research Centre (DTRC) and till 1985 it was known as the International Institute for Population Studies (IIPS). It is the autonomous institution sponsored jointly by the Government of India, the United Nations and Sir Dorabji Tata Trust. The Institute is under the administrative control of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India. The Institute was awarded deemed university status in 1985. To conduct the academic program (teaching and research) in the field of demography / population studies is major activity of the Institute. To make the academic program successful the library has its own indispensable place. The IIPS library is well known to the world for its resources and effective services. It has the combination of printed volumes, online and electronic documents as well as application of advance technology to deliver the service.

Digitization of Census Volumes 1881-1941 is one of our successfully completed projects taken for preservation of rare (special) collection by International Institute for Population Sciences (IIPS), library. Keeping in mind, to provide multi-access, to exchange the available digitized volume/s, to fill up the gap of unavailable census volume/s from other organizations / libraries / persons and to provide

digitized data to the society are the objectives set for the work. Above all, the IIPS is interested to develop the digitized collection of entire publications of Census of India 1872 – 1941 for its library and to help others in the process of complete their own census database if desired.

Demographic information is the major requirement of the scholars, academicians, planners, social workers, government and non-government agencies. Census reports are considered as major demographic information source and main ingredient of the academic activities of the Institute. Realizing the importance of this source, the Institute library has procured maximum census reports i.e. Census of India 1872-1951 in microfiche forms of 4458 reels. But because of the humid climate of Mumbai, all the reels have been spoiled, at present microfiche form reels are not available in the market and as an alternative source, the library had taken initiative to digitize printed volumes of 1881 – 1941 which are available in the library. Unfortunately the library could not have all the census reports but the efforts have been made to preserve the important demographic information and we also invite the libraries / organizations to join the hands to share the demographic information and develop the complete digital database of the census 1872-1941. The organizations those who have the census volumes which are not available with IIPS library are welcome to submit the proposal for the digitization of their volumes, the Institute library will digitize them and return to the organization along with the digitized copy. We would like to extend our service to the interested sisterhood organizations / libraries that, those who would like to submit the proposal for digitization of the missing volumes, we will be happy to provide a copy of the digitized volume (desired by the organization / library) if they don't have and if they are interested to fill up their gap, it will be provided one additional volume available with us for one digitized volume. It means if the IIPS received the proposal for the digitization of ten volumes which we don't have, the digitized volumes (in PDF format) and original printed volumes along with additional ten digitized (desired) volumes which are available with us will be provided and that is how we would like to develop the database of Census of India 1872-1941.

The table no.1 shows that, the census volumes of first three decades i.e. 1872, 1881 and 1891 there is huge gap in between published census volumes and not available in IIPS. No single volume is available published as Census of India 1872, further for of 2nd and 3rd decades very few volumes are available. Around 60% volumes of the total census publications which are published during 1872-1941 is the actual gap for which we would like to make an announcement with this text is:

Any organization in India or abroad has the above missing volume/s, we would be very happy to digitize the volumes for which we will provide a digitized copy (DVD) + original census volume. We will keep one digitized copy of the above volume in the Institute library. All the cost will be bared by the Institute for this work. This data will be used for academic purpose and not commercial purpose.

In case if any organization is also interested to have the census volume in digitized form which we have and they don't, matter will be solved on exchange basis. The required agency should digitize the volume and provide a digitize copy to IIPS and they should put the demand for the substitute from the list of available volumes. This type of exchange of volumes, the IIPS will not charge any amount; it will be substitute with desired available volume. (DVD will be substitute with DVD)

It is also quite possible that some of the libraries may not willing to give the printed volumes to the IIPS due to restrictions. In this case if they digitized themselves either commercially or in-house and provide a CD / DVD to the IIPS, after receiving the CD/DVD if the organization provide a list of required volume which we already digitized, we will send equal number of volumes without any charge. The exchanged information will be used only for academic purpose but not for commercial.

The list of census volumes in chronological order for the period of 1871-1942 is as given in annexure 1. *(Italian script [bold] items in the annexure 1 are available in digitized form with IIPS library in PDF form and for remaining titles the institute is looking for the library from any other source)*. The Italian & bold title extended with figure in bracket stating the number of pages and further six digit number started with single (0) zero or multiple (00...) zeros stating accession number of that specific census volumes. It can be used for calculation of digitization cost of the volume and tracing it from the library.
